Warehouse Strategy and Process Improvement

- Assist in setting KPIs, performance standards and annual improvement targets
- Participate in annual Supply Chain meeting
- Ensure that plans are executed in a timely fashion and that they are monitored for their effectiveness

- Health & Safety, comply with Federal & Provincial legislation related to the facility, personnel, and equipment

Leadership & Direction
